Visiting Fellows & Scholars

The College welcomes Visiting Fellows and Scholars. College membership provides a point of intellectual contact within a scholarly and social environment. It also gives access to the many libraries and other facilities of the University, as well as the opportunity to make contact with scholars working in a range of academic disciplines.

Visiting Fellows and Scholars can expect the following benefits from an association with St Edmund's College:

- University/meal Card for dining in College (the University card can be issued to visitors who are resident in Cambridge for one month or more, up to 12 months).
- Access to the University Library and Departmental Libraries
- A small and friendly academic environment

Potential Visiting Fellows of the appropriate eligibility should contact the Master's office at the address given below or by email to masters.office@st-edmunds.cam.ac.uk and guidance will be given about submitting a formal application. All visitor applications are presented to the Nominations Committee for recommendation to go forward to the Governing Body, for election. The Master will write and inform applicants of the outcome after the Governing Body has met.

Potential Visiting Scholars of the appropriate eligibility should contact the Master's office at the address given below or by email to masters.office@st-edmunds.cam.ac.uk. Applications are considered by the Nominations Committee and recommended to go forward to Council for approval and appointment. The Master will write to the applicant shortly after Council has met. Visiting Fellows and Scholars are normally expected to provide evidence that they have arranged either an association with a Fellow of the College, a University Department, or a contact within a Department in the University of Cambridge with whom they will work during their stay and can show that they will be fully funded during their visit. The College may not accept an application that does not comply with these criteria. The Nominations Committee usually meets once per term. Applications received in the summer vacation will be processed at the first available Nominations Committee meeting in the Michaelmas Term. Applicants are advised to apply at least one term in advance of their planned visit.

Please note that it is not always possible to provide visitors with College accommodation except during the summer long vacation and most Visiting Fellows and Visiting Scholars live outside the College. However, all Visiting Fellows and Visiting Scholars are encouraged to become involved in College activities, which include seminars, lectures and College Guest Nights.
