



Ayman K. Agbaria completed his PhD in Educational Theory and Policy and International and Comparative Education at Penn State University. Dr. Agbaria has two graduate degrees, one in Criminology, from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and the other in International Development and Social Change from Clark University. Currently, he works as a lecturer in the Department of Policy and Leadership in Education at Haifa University. Worth to note, Dr. Agbaria is a published poet and playwright. His poetry is widely anthologized, and has appeared in several prestigious literary periodicals in several languages. Dr. Agbaria has been a guest writer at several cultural institutions, among them Cove Park in Scotland, and The Royal Court Theatre in London.
